

Dog Vaccination Schedule

Welcome to Petimin Family...

Puppies are at risk of serious diseases because their immune systems are not yet developed. Therefore, it is very important to start vaccination at an early age. Vaccines are applied to protect against diseases that are difficult or impossible to treat. In order to get the most out of vaccination, the dog must be free of parasites and stress-free. An existing dog should never be vaccinated without veterinary approval.

After adopting your dog, it is recommended that he/she stays in quarantine with you for at least a week. After observing his/her health status and ensuring that there are no signs of illness, vaccinations can be started. During this process, your puppy's general condition, eating habits, fecal and urinary characteristics, and mental status should be carefully monitored and your observations should be shared with your veterinarian. Until the vaccination program is completed, your dog should not be bathed with water or have close contact with other dogs.

Antiparasitic applications can be performed with appropriate active ingredients in puppies younger than 8 weeks of age with the approval of a veterinarian. The vaccination program in puppies is most appropriately started at 6 weeks of age. During this period, the Puppy DP vaccine is first applied. The vaccination schedule continues with the combined vaccine to be administered at 9 weeks.

13. Week	Corona Vac. (2. Dos.)	Corona virüs	Once a year
14. Week	Bronchin Vac. (2. Dos.)	Bordotella Bronchoseptica	Once a year
15. Week	Kuduz Vac.	Rabies	Once a year
